The activities of VARD during the financial year 2015-16

The projects area mainly consists in the Mayurbhanj district of Odisha. The area is fully covered with tribal belt by the hamlets of different types of tribal communities like Ho, Ganda, Bhuiyan, Santals, Munda, Lodha, Gram, Karu, Dewar and Banol etc. The major sources of income of the inhabitants are daily wage agriculture returns and forest products. Agriculture is the backbone of the people. There is no source of irrigation facility but due to draft and the global climate change the situation is very complex. In other seasons they mostly depended upon the forest products and daily wages in the outside of District.



A. Awareness Programme on Road Safety:

VARD organised the various activities under the Road safety programme in the district of Mayurbhanj under the financial assistance and guidance from R.T.O. Mayurbhanj and State Transport Authority, Odisha, Cuttack. Most of the programmes are school programme with

involving the community member towards the importance of safety use of Road and it proper consciousness of the various rule and signals of the safety drive. The rally, hooding, poster, cultural programme, awareness camps also organised in different places of Mayurbhanj.

B. Eye Camps for Drivers:

VARD organised the eye tasting camps for the community mainly maintained their livelihood by engaging them in the driving occupation. The programme is organised under the financial assistance and guidance from R.T.O, Mayurbhanj, Health checkups, eye tasting. Blood Pressure, Blood Groups etc were carried out by the qualified doctors to achieve the main object of the programme.

C. Road Accident Help Line:

VARD organised this programme on behalf of Odisha Road Safety Society, Cuttack under guidance by RTO, Mayurbhanj.



D. Organic Agricultural Programme:

Agriculture is one of the major activities where women were actively involved. In mountain agriculture is consider being a marginal activity as it pays back scarcity, but at the same time it is the most important activity as it is directly link with the sustenance of the village. Due to lake of opportunity the activity in the hills pays one-day food after three days labours. Thrust on the high productivity has never been attempted for next many decades. Appropriate technology intervention can play role for better output and can also reduce the drudgery of the women.

Agriculture is the backbone of our country. Most of the people were depend on agriculture. For increase in productivity the farmers use chemical pesticides, chemical fertiliser which cause loss

of productivity, which is shortage of food grain yearend. Most of the agriculture land was washed up by food and become unfertile soil, result is less agroproduct. VARD organised awareness, workshop and farmers training camp on use of biofartilizer and biopestisides in their agriculture land for better production in block area of Mayurbhanj district.

E. Family Counselling:

Controlling the family violence cases at community level it is one of the most challenging programme of VARD. VARD organising various village meetings, seminars motivating to women and men to use contraceptive and promotion of condom as a family planning procedure. Mobilising the Govt. and allied departments to work jointly to overcome the situation.

F. Farmers Club:

The Farmers club promoted by VARD at khasadiha during 2013-14 is functioning properly. The organisation as a regular contact with the club and provide various agricultural informations about Govt. Schemes.

G. S.H.Groups :

VARD organised 176 groups at Hatikote, Budhikhamari, Badjod & Bhagabatachandrapur G.P. under Baripada Block.

H. Women and Gender empowerment programme:

There is a need to generate self-employment among the venerable group women, tribal and disabled people. Instead of selling the raw products to traders at margin rates they can prepare finished or semi-finished products and sell them to the government marketing department, such as ORMAS, DSMS, ITDA and allied departments. VARD also provide technical support to preparation of finished product. The programmes mainly strengthen the activities like; capacity building, gender empowerment etc as a main object of VARD. The community now playing as catalysts for the village development plan and involve in various activities related to health and development.
